

A Typical Day...

A typical 4 hour day at Little Monsters Academy includes:



STRUCTURED LEARNING TIME (2 x 30 minute blocks)

Sitting with a teacher in groups of 4 to 6 performing hands on activities to practice fine motor skills, number & letter recognition, phonics, and basic science concepts.

OUTDOOR PLAY (1 hour)

Visiting the playground or forest area in Memorial South Park, or going on the occasional neighborhood walk.

FREE PLAY (1 hour)

Choosing their own activities, playing with friends, and socializing.

GROUP CIRCLE TIME (15 minutes opening & 30 minutes closing)

Reading, music, or conversations about the weekly theme, or exercise.

SNACK TiME (30 minutes)

Fresh fruits, veggies, grains & dairy served every class.

☼ Outdoor Play @ Memorial South Park

We take the children to Memorial South Park for one hour each class unless the weather presents a safety hazard to children.



Memorial South Park features a playground, 30 acres of green space, sporting facilities, public washrooms, and clean facilities. The park and surrounding neighborhood are safe, and we have permission from the Vancouver Park Board to use the park daily.

S Free Play & Socialization

We dedicate a minimum of 45 minutes per class to free play, allowing our students to choose their own activities and play with their friends.





Structured Learning Time

Our structured learning time consists of two 30 minute blocks in which students sit with a teacher in groups of five or six and practice various age appropriate lessons, as well as group activities and science experiments.















Group Circle Time

Group circle time involves the entire class sitting together in the library area and participating in one of the following activities:

- Group discussion about the weekly theme
- Show & share (bringing a toy from home)
- Reading a story (based on the weekly theme)
- Children's Yoga, or other exercises
- Music & dancing

Keeping Children Safe



Every teacher has training and valid certification in child specific First-Aid and CPR.



Every teacher is a certified Early Childhood Educator under the Community Care and Assisted Living Act, has cleared RCMP background checks, and is notarized by a medical professional to be of sound mind and able to work with young children.



Preparing and serving food to young children is part of our training, and we take extra precautions to ensure children are served meals that are safe and free from choking hazards or things that may cause allergic reactions.



We are always cleaning. Our facility is sanitized twice daily, and our toys and classroom materials are sanitized at the end of every school day.



All toys and classroom materials are age appropriate for children 30 to 60 months (2.5 to 5 years).



Our facility remains locked during class time, with the exception of scheduled pick-up and drop-off times.
